

**RESIDENTIAL SITES** Generally booked for minimum two nights for overnight camps, or can be used for up to 30 people for daytime training or meetings. Both are wheelchair accessible.

**ROBINS ROOST** - Year round facility, sleeps 30 campers in bunks with mattresses. Large washroom for girls and a leaders washroom with a shower. Kitchen with commercial propane gas stove with grill & oven, fridge, deep freezer, dishes, cutlery, pots & pans, cleaning supplies. There is an enclosed outdoor area suitable for activities and crafts. Chairs and folding tables are on site. Flag pole, campfire ring has benches & firewood supplied.

**MARION'S MANOR** - Year round facility sleeps up to 28 campers in bunks with mattresses. Modern, fully equipped kitchen same as Robin's Roost. Indoor washroom. Covered outside area with picnic tables. Flag pole, campfire ring has benches & firewood supplied.

**CAMPSITES**

**SHERWOOD & CAMELOT**—each have seven 9X12 ridge pole platform tents, additional space available to pitch your own tents if needed. Large shelter has food preparation area with fridge, counter space, 3 burner propane stove, deep freezer, wood burning heater. Electricity and coffee pot. Picnic tables, firewood & campfire area. Must bring food storage bins.

**Avalon**— semi-wilderness site for smaller groups, cooking shelter with 3 burner propane stove & wood burning heater, LDP, firewood & firepit, no tents provided. NO ELECTRICITY, water and large sink.

Sherwood—washrooms facilities are at the end of Marion's Manor  
 Camelot & Avalon—washroom building has flush toilets on Camelot site to be shared.



**BOOKING PROCEDURE**

Bookings made on a first call basis.  
 September 1st. to book for January - August  
 April 1st. to book for September - December

Booking may be done by phone or e-mail to the booking agent.

When a site and date have been booked, it will be held for ten days to allow time for the following to be sent-

**1. Booking Fee** (to be dated with current date) -see chart below for amount. As this is part of the total camp cost it is deducted from your final total.

**2. Damage / Security Deposit** is \$100.00 per site and is returned after your camp if there is no cause for there to be any charges. (Cheque to be dated the date of your camp)

When these are received by the Booking Agent the booking is then **confirmed**.

Payment of the Minimum camp fee is required 30 days prior to your camp. (see chart below for rates)  
 The Calculation will be—

Min. people X number of nights X rate less the booking fee which was paid in advance.

Make all cheques payable to Girl Guides of Canada, Camp McLanlin and mail to the booking agent. To receive receipts and the return of your damage deposit please include a stamped, self addressed envelope.

**Cancellation of Camp** is required at least 2 months before your scheduled camp date or you will be responsible for the minimum payment. However, you may find a replacement to take your reservation. Please inform the booking agent of any changes.

Should you **fail to show** for your camp—you will be responsible for payment of the Minimum rate.

For Groups OUTSIDE our Assessment Area

We appreciate your use and support of Camp McLanlin and we are happy to take your reservation after November 1st. for January to August bookings for the next year, and after June 1st. For balance of the current year.

Camp McLanlin is open throughout the summer months for residential & outdoor camping for two night or longer camps for Guiding groups.

### Directions:-

- Hwy 1 East to Whatcom Rd. Exit 95
- Turn Left over freeway
- Right on North Parallel Rd. 2.3 km.
- Left on Sumas Mtn. Rd. 5.2 km (follow double yellow line road markings) to 4 way stop.
- Left on Dawson Rd. 1.3 km.
- Right on Willet Rd. 1.3 km to entrance gate of Camp MAC
- Follow sign to Heritage Valley (situated corner of Dawson & Willet Rd.)

### Camp McLanlin General Information

“Camp Mac” is supported by Cheam, Peace Arch, Delrey and the Delta Districts of Fraser Delta Area and managed by the Camp McLanlin Board of Management. The board consists of representatives from these areas & districts. It is used by approx. 6,500 Guiding members from all levels, girls & adults, for short & long term camps as well as for adult training evenings & weekends. It can also be rented for day use activities.

- Chapel—situated above Camelot nestled within the forest, complete with chimes.
- Water is available at all campsites & residences and is tested on a regular basis by the Public Health Unit.
- Garbage: Currently all garbage & recyclables must be taken home by the group after camp, there is no pickup for garbage disposal at camp.
- Site Map Trails: available at the camp
- Crests can be purchased from the caretaker at the camp with a unit cheque only
- Firewood: dry firewood provided at all sites, bring your own axe and newspaper.
- Pets are NOT allowed at camp. This is a Provincial health regulation.
- Creek: is out of bounds. No wading or bathing as this is a water source to residents downstream.
- GAMES: Book with caretaker upon arrival for archery, bocce, badminton volley ball and water slide.
- Common Field: situated near Camelot & Avalon—for use by all groups/sites.
- Picnic Tables are secured in place, please do not move as this will cause damage to these tables and the ground around the campsite.
- Gadget Wood—there can be a lot of windfall in the area for gadget building and use. Please use only fallen sticks and return to wooded area untied upon completion of camp.

#### NOTE—

Cell phone reception is very limited at the Camp site because of the mountainous terrain.
