

MARGERY DUMFRIES SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria

This scholarship was established by the family and friends of Margery Dumfries in memory and recognition of her many years of service to Guiding as provincial secretary, provincial Cadet coordinator and Member of provincial committees, and her untiring involvement in training and local Guiding.

OBJECTIVES

- To further promote the Mission and Values of Girl Guides of Canada
- To encourage further education/training for members of the Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada **at a recognized post-secondary institution such as a junior college, community college, technical school or university in Canada**

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Be an active Member of Girl Guides of Canada
2. Have been an active Member of Girl Guides of Canada for the immediate past five years
3. Be a resident of British Columbia, Canada
4. Be completing her final year of secondary education
5. Be planning to attend a recognized post-secondary institution such as a junior college, community college, technical school or university in Canada
6. Show a commitment to service in her school and community

REQUIREMENTS

1. Preference will be given to applicants showing a background, interest and/or prospective career in the **sciences, engineering or agriculture**.
2. This scholarship is conditional on acceptance at the institution of the recipient's choice.
3. This scholarship will be awarded only when **proof of registration** (in the form of a receipt for tuition paid) and **the recipient's Social Insurance Number** have been received by the BC Girl Guides provincial awards committee.
4. This scholarship must be used **within 18 months of notification date**.
5. The recipient must agree to have her name and photograph publicized.
6. The recipient is encouraged to continue her involvement in Guiding in whatever way possible.

Candidates will be evaluated on the following:

- Guiding history and involvement
- Service/volunteer involvement
- Additional interests and activities
- Scholastic achievement
- Confidential recommendation from within Guiding
- Confidential recommendation from outside of Guiding
- Applicant's letter about the importance of Guiding and service in her life
