

PAT DRUGGE ADULT BURSARY FUND

Criteria

This bursary was established by BC Guiding Members to recognize the many contributions to Guiding by Pat Drugge. Initial contributions to the fund were in the form of a retirement gift to Pat from her Guiding friends as she completed her term as Provincial Commissioner.

OBJECTIVE

To assist Guiders who have a need for financial assistance to further and/or upgrade their education or job skills

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

- The Pat Drugge Adult Bursary Fund is open for donations. Income tax receipts will be provided upon request.
- 5.5% of the Pat Drugge Adult Bursary Fund, as of January 1 of current year, will be available for distribution. The number and value of grants awarded in a year is at the discretion of the committee.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this bursary the applicant must:

1. Be 25 years or older
2. Be an active adult Member in good standing of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada
3. Have been active in BC Guiding over the immediate past three years

GUIDELINES

1. Bursary grants will be considered for education of all types, including high school equivalency, technical or career programs and college or university courses.
2. Pat Drugge Adult Bursary grants may be applied to tuition or other expenses such as childcare, books, supplies and transportation.
3. Application forms are available from Girl Guides of Canada, BC Council. To be considered, they must be filled out **completely with no additional information and must meet the deadline.**
4. This bursary is conditional on acceptance at the institution of the recipient's choice.
5. This bursary will only be awarded when **proof of registration** (in the form of a receipt for tuition paid) and the **recipient's Social Insurance Number** have been received by the BC Girl Guides provincial awards committee.
6. At the discretion of the committee, a recipient(s) **may defer the use of the grant for up to 18 months from notification date.**
7. Recipient(s) **must** agree to have her name and photograph publicized as a recipient of the Pat Drugge Adult Bursary, Girl Guides of Canada, BC Council, and to provide the committee with a write-up of approximately 150 words about how the bursary has assisted her toward reaching her goal. This is to be submitted by September 15 of the year following receipt of the bursary, and may be published.
8. Recipient(s) is to continue her involvement in Guiding in whatever way possible.
9. Recipient(s) and applicant(s) will be notified of the results immediately after selections.
10. Formal announcement of recipient(s) will be announced at the BC provincial annual meeting and published in *Pipeline*.
11. Unsuccessful applicants may reapply.
12. Successful recipient(s) may reapply once only.

Candidates will be evaluated in terms of the following:

- Guide history
- Service/volunteer involvement
- Additional interests and activities
- Employment positions held
- Candidate's letter
