#### **Shortbread Recipe**

Shortbread cookies are a nice addition to afternoon tea or as a dessert after a traditional meal of bubble and squeak and shepherd's pie!

- 1 cup butter
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 1/4 cups flour
- 1/2 cup cornstarch

1. Preheat oven to 225° F. Using an electric beater, cream the butter, then add the sugar until very light.
2. Sift the flour and cornstarch together. Fold into the creamed mixture. Roll out the dough and cut into desired shapes. Bake for 35 minutes or until golden brown. Sprinkle with granulated sugar if desired.

#### **Game: Sticky Witch**

Sticky Witch: A fun game for Sparks and Brownies!

*Equipment:* 4 circles- 1m metre in diameter (hula hoops or skipping ropes)  
Large playing area

*Set-up:* Lay out the 4 circles around the play area. The circles must be big enough for a few girls to stand inside.

*How to Play:* Choose one girl to be the Sticky Witch. The Sticky Witch is "covered in glue" and must work to catch the other girls who are running free. Any girl caught by the Sticky Witch holds hands with the Sticky Witch until she is placed in a glue pot (circle). Anyone in a glue pot becomes sticky and can catch other girls by leaning out of the glue pot. The last one to be caught becomes the Sticky Witch for the next game.

**Craft- Edelweiss**

Edelweiss is the national flower of Switzerland. Use one of the ideas below to make a craft. Either make a:

- Wood block with a "burned" design (using sharpies) after indenting the wood with a blunt object.
- Draw and paint the edelweiss.
- Use yellow and white fimo to create a pin or magnet using red fimo for the banner of Switzerland and small rolled tubes of white for lettering.
- Use felt to create a soft edelweiss.
