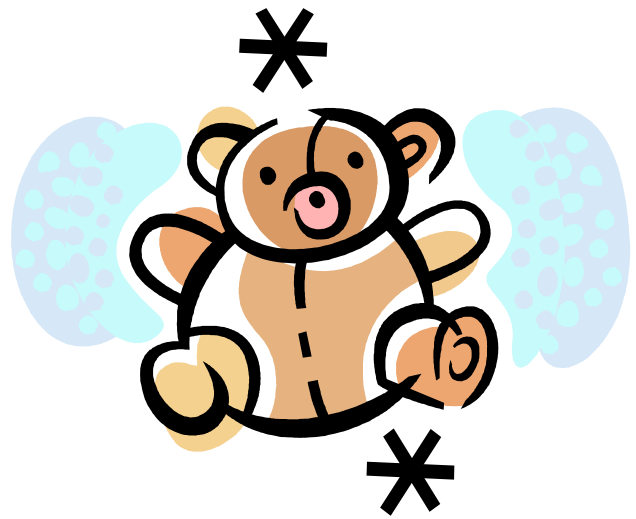


CHEAM AND PEACE ARCH
