

CWFF Pizza Challenge 2018

The Canadian World Friendship Fund Pizza Challenge returns once again for 2018 – with your choice of 4 slices to possibly complete your pizza!

The BC International Committee challenges each Unit to collect the most money per Unit member (including Guiders) for the Canadian World Friendship Fund. All you have to do is collect the money, fill in the entry form, return it to the Provincial International Committee and forward the money to your District treasurer

There will be a prize for one Unit at each level of Guiding. The unit in each branch that collects the most money per unit member (including Guiders), will win up to \$100.00 to be used for a pizza party for the Unit. That means that a Sparks Unit, a Brownie Unit, a Guide Unit, a Pathfinder Unit and a Ranger Unit can each win up to \$100.00 for a pizza party.

An additional prize of up to \$100.00 for a pizza party will be awarded to the BC unit that uses the most original fundraising activity in this challenge.
