

LEAP 2019 – Ontario Provincial Camp  
August 3 – 14, 2019  
Information Sheet - Participant Application details



<b>What</b>	Participate in LEAP 2019, an Ontario provincial camp designed for adventurers and explorers hosting up to 2,500 campers. A LEAP camper will discover everything she can be while participating in incredible Guiding activities, making memories, developing confidence and leadership skills and meeting many new. After camp, travel to Toronto, stay in a hostel and explore the area including a day trip to Niagara Falls.
<b>Where</b>	Vancouver to gather, Doe Lake Camp, Ontario, and Toronto, Ontario
<b>When</b>	August 3 – 14, 2019 (approximately)
<b>Who</b>	<b>Sixteen (16) girls born in 2003 and 2006 + four (4) alternates Two (2) Guiders + Two (2) Alternate Guider/s</b>
<b>Cost</b>	The total value of this program is approximately \$3000 per person. Girl members will receive a subsidy of \$2400, making the invoice amount \$600 per girl. Guiders will receive a subsidy of 100% trip costs. This includes all costs associated with this trip (meals, accommodation, local and flight travel costs, program, entry fees and trip cancellation/interruption insurance.) BC Council travel policy for girls and Guiders attending Provincial events will apply for participants' travel to and from Vancouver.

Not included in the event fee

- Travel medical insurance
- Kit list and uniform requirements
- Spending money for souvenirs

If you need additional financial support, please check with your Area Camping Adviser to see if your Area and or District Councils may be able to assist you with this event. Girl members may fundraise part of their trip cost by following the fundraising policy and procedures (Governance Policy 01-19-01).

#### Qualifications

- Six consecutive or non-consecutive nights away from home with Girl Guides of Canada (Minimum of 2 night in a row.)
- Ability to adapt and work co-operatively.
- Ability to cope with daily camp and travel activities.
- Completed swim or boat test record in iMIS by March 1, 2019.
- **Guiders must have Standard First Aid certification valid during travel and entered in iMIS by March 1, 2019.**

- Camping Record Sheet
- Reference contact information (2 - one Guiding one non-Guiding)

It is your responsibility to tell the persons you are asking to fill out references for you the details of the camp(s) you are applying for and to give them plenty of time to meet your deadline.

If you are applying for more than one camp, one application is sufficient, but you must answer all the questions keeping in mind the different types you are applying for.

**Incomplete, late, or faxed applications will not be accepted.**

Submit your application online no later than **November 1st, 2018**

***\*You will be notified via email about whether you have been selected by late December 2018.***
