

BC TREFOIL GUILDS' EDUCATION GRANT CRITERIA

Only the current June 01 2011 application form will be accepted.

This Education Grant was established by BC Trefoil Guild Members to commemorate the 100th Birthday of Guiding in Canada. Funds were donated by Trefoil Guilds and individual Members throughout BC.

OBJECTIVE

To provide funding to Members age 19-30 as they further their education

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

- Donations may be made to the BC Trefoil Guilds' Education Grant at any time.
- Income tax receipts will be provided for donations of \$10.00 or more.
- The value of the grant(s) given each year will be dependent on the interest earned from the BC Trefoil Guilds' Education Grant Fund. The number and value of grants awarded in a year is at the discretion of the committee.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this grant the applicant must:

1. Be 19-30 years of age.
2. Be an active Member in good standing of the Girl Guides of Canada – Guides du Canada.
3. Have been active in BC Guiding for the immediate past three years.

GUIDELINES

1. Grants will be considered for education of all types, including high school equivalency, technical or career programs, and college or university courses.
2. Current application forms are available from Girl Guides of Canada, BC Council website www.bc-girlguides.org/resources/bursaries-and-scholarships/. To be considered, current application forms must be filled out **completely** with no additional information and **must meet the deadline**.
3. This grant is conditional on acceptance at the institution of the recipient's choice.
4. This grant will be awarded when proof of registration, in the form of a receipt for tuition paid, and the recipient's Social Insurance Number have been received by the BC Girl Guides, Provincial Awards Committee.
5. At the discretion of the committee, a recipient(s) may defer the use of the grant for up to 18 months from notification date.
6. Recipient(s) must agree to have name and photograph publicized.
7. Recipient(s) is to continue her involvement in Guiding in whatever way possible.
8. Applicants will be notified of the results after selections.
9. Formal announcement of recipient(s) will be announced at the BC Provincial Annual General Meeting and published in *Pipeline*.
10. Unsuccessful applicants may re-apply (In subsequent years).

- Employment positions held
- Applicants Letter - Future career plans
