



### **ORIGIN OF BOOK OF HONOUR**

The Book of Honour was created to recognize outstanding BC Guiders and girls who exemplify the spirit of Guiding through keeping the Promise and Law.

The objectives were two-fold:

1. To create a special, lasting form of recognition of outstanding Members throughout the years.
2. To help fund the Bursary of Honour, which will encourage education/training at a post-secondary institution for Members of Girl Guides of Canada – Guides du Canada, who are graduating from Grade 12 in a given year.

### **DUPLICATE BOOK OF HONOUR**

This is a duplicate version of the archival Book of Honour, which is kept on display in a secure case in the lobby of Guide House.

The travelling duplicate book is available to be shared throughout the province at area events, conferences, and workshops, so that everyone has the opportunity to see the book, and may think of someone else who deserves to be included. It is important that the Duplicate Book of Honour be reserved well in advance of the date required so that arrangements can be made to send it to you in time for this occasion.

The person listed as the “Contact Person” on the Reservation Form will be responsible for the safekeeping of the Duplicate Book of Honour within the area. This person is also responsible for returning it to Guide House by the stated date.

The Duplicate Book of Honour must be returned to Guide House within 10 days of the presentation date.

### **METHODS BY WHICH THE DUPLICATE BOOK OF HONOUR CAN BE OBTAINED:**

- It can be picked up at Guide House.  
or
- It can be sent to your area by courier (at area’s expense).
