Only the current June 2011 application form will be accepted.

This scholarship was established by the family and friends of Margery Dumfries in memory and recognition of her many years of service to Guiding as provincial secretary, provincial Cadet Coordinator, Member of provincial committees and her untiring involvement in training and local Guiding.

OBJECTIVES

- To further promote the Vision, Mission and Values of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada.
- To encourage further education/training for Members of the Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada at a recognized post-secondary institution such as a junior college, community college, technical school or university in Canada.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Be an active Member of Girl Guide of Canada-Guides du Canada.
2. Have been active Member of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada.
3. Be a resident of British Columbia, Canada.
4. Be completing her final year of secondary education.
5. Be planning to attend a recognized post-secondary institution such as a junior college, community college, technical school or university in Canada.
6. Show a commitment to service in her school and community.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Preference will be given to applicants showing a background, interest and /or prospective career in the **sciences, engineering or agriculture**.
2. This scholarship is conditional on acceptance at the institution of the recipient's choice.
3. This scholarship will be awarded only when proof of registration (in the form of a receipt for tuition paid) and the recipient's Social Insurance Number have been received by the BC Girl Guides Provincial Awards Committee.
4. This scholarship must be used within 18 months of notification date.
5. The recipient must agree to have her name and photograph publicized.
6. The recipient is encouraged to continue her involvement in Guiding.

- Experiences outside of Guiding
- Scholastic achievement
- Future career plans
- Reference letter (Guiding)
- Reference letter (Outside Guiding)
- Applicant's letter about the importance of Guiding and service in her life
