TERMS OF REFERENCE

PURPOSE

To stimulate and promote an active interest in the Guiding Program throughout the Province.

MEMBERS

- Girl Programs' specialist
- Communications liaison
- Active Living adviser
- Environment adviser
- Inclusivity/Diversity champion

RESPONSIBILITIES

In addition to the Generic Terms of Reference, the Provincial Program Committee shall:

1. Explore, investigate and promote new ways of enhancing, enriching and presenting the girls' programs.
2. Be responsible for the promotion and administration of BC Lones.
3. Help advise and promote Rangers through the Provincial Ranger Sub Committee/Ranger Advisory Committee (RAC).
4. Help make Guiding accessible to girls and women throughout BC. Increase awareness, understanding and acceptance within Guiding of members with special needs; embrace cultural awareness, diversity and inclusivity in programs for all branches.
5. Promote environmental awareness for Guiders and girls through trainings, camps and activities.
6. Increase interest in science and technology through trainings, special events and activities.
7. Organize and conduct Provincial events as necessary.
8. Promote awareness of Program resources available to Guiders through *Pipeline*, *The News RAC*, *On My Own*, *Fun Finder* and the website.
9. Promote active living, including health eating, fitness, self esteem and other lifestyle issues for girls and Guiders through trainings, special events and activities.

These Terms of Reference to be reviewed every two years.
