You'll receive a Challenge Certificate by return mail.

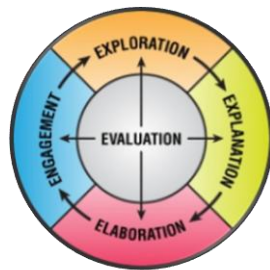
1. TRAINING AND ENRICHMENT FOR ADULT MEMBERS (TEAM)
